They speak of the second half of our mission: to provide opportunities for volunteers to join with elders in the celebration of life.

Over thirty-five years ago our Boston doors opened and we began the wonderful work of bringing volunteers like Shirley together with lonely and isolated elderly women and men. Some say that we are creating friendships, but I rather think of it as opening doors – providing opportunities for people to welcome others into their lives. This is what happens every day at Little Brothers-Friends of the Elderly: doors are opened, companionship is offered, service is given – lives are made better.

Last year we saw 1,690 volunteers knock on doors and give 31,770 hours of friendship and service to our old friends. You will see how these hours were spent and glimpse the faces of some of the 839 elderly women and men who welcomed us into their lives.

I sincerely hope that these slides bring a smile to your face, and that they serve as proof of the value of your contributions. 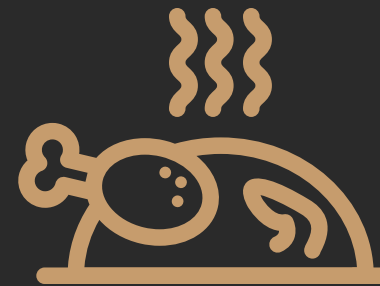

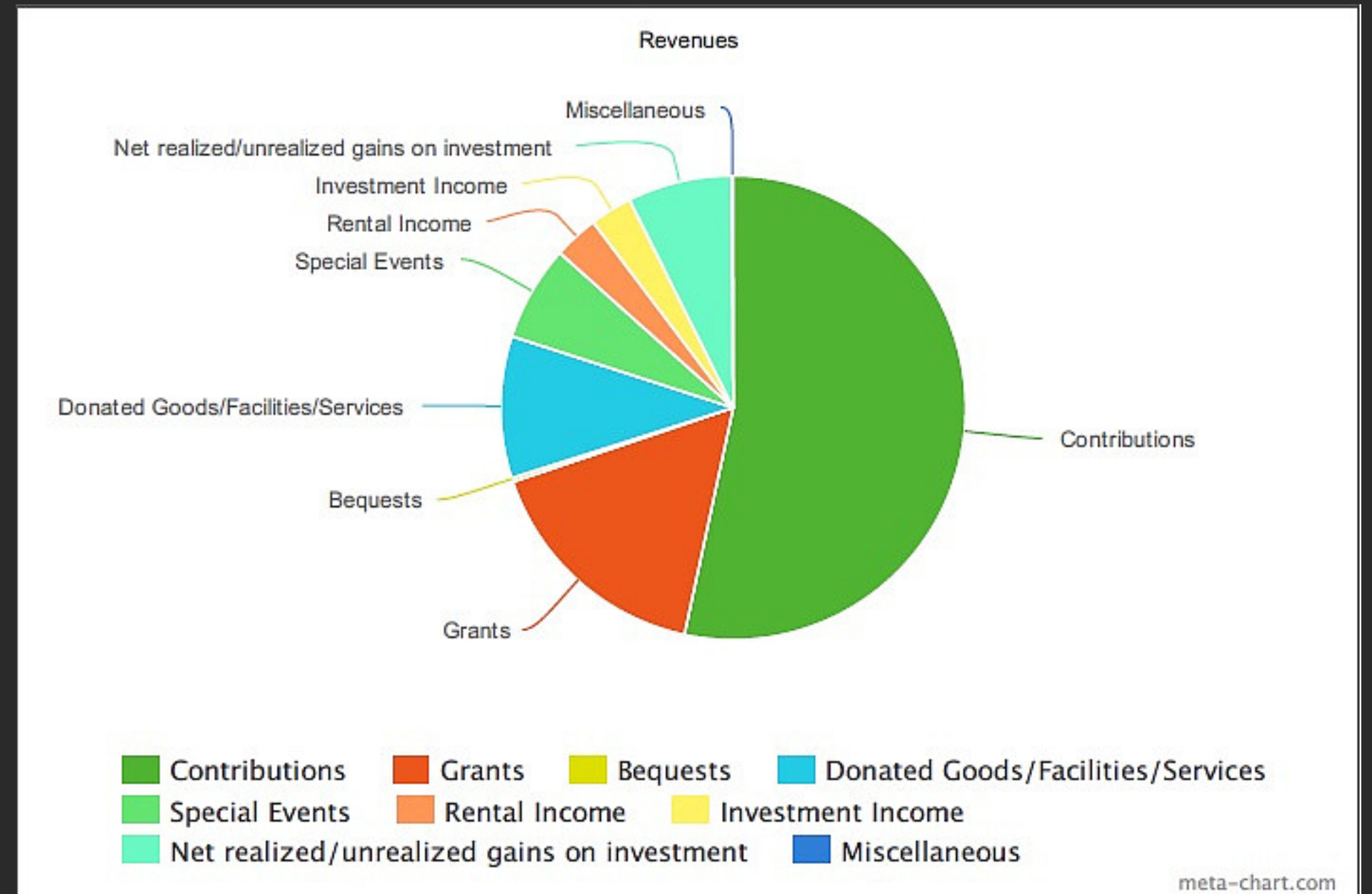

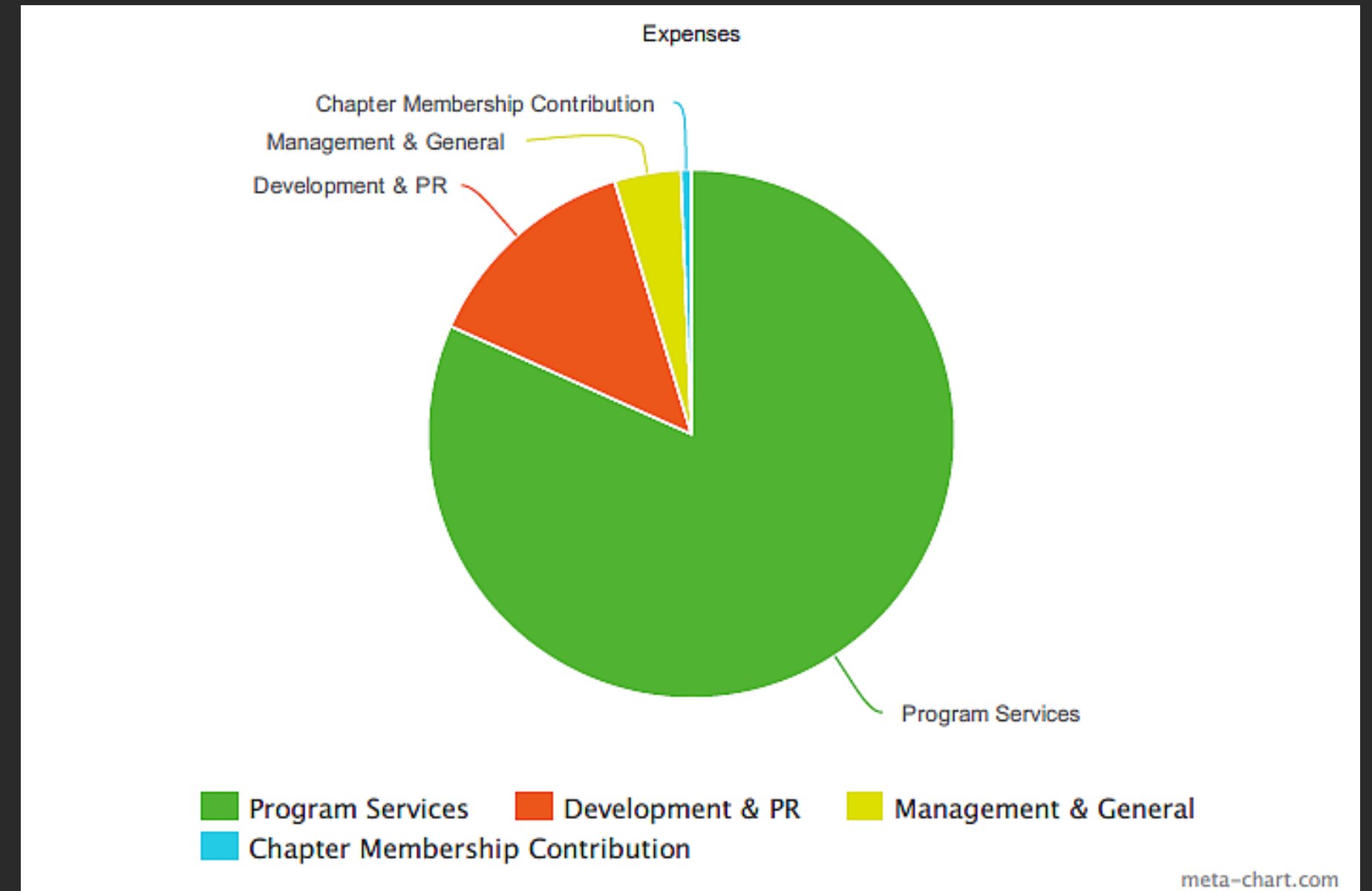

Why I Support Little Brothers

I first heard about Little Brothers-Friends of the Elderly as I happened upon a Yard Sale they were hosting at their South End facility on Columbus Ave in 1984. I found the folks there to be very charming and sweet, and there was a "funkiness" to the operation at the time. The building was old and cramped, but people made due - intent on service to the elderly.

They had a sign up sheet for volunteers at the Yard Sale and as I love to cook, they put me in the kitchen for the holidays. They eventually connected me with a perfect match - a couple who lived just a few doors away from me: Henry & Mamie.

I was always attuned to older folks and at that time was very close to my Grandmother. When I was very young I was brought to a downtrodden ward in a nursing home to see a relative: the shock of it made an impression on me and made me want to help older folks.

I think the work of Little Brothers is crucial: we live in times of disparity and of sometimes grinding isolation. In a time when we're made to think we're so connected

through technology, we also yearn for more meaningful, truer connections - both for volunteers and for isolated elders. As I mentioned above my first match by Little Brothers was a very powerful gift. A particular thrill has been to become a father and to share the experience with my daughters.

Mamie and Henry were dear friends. Henry's death in 1990 was very sad but I stayed close with Mamie through the years, and am very glad that she got to know my children.

When Mamie moved into a nursing home we continued to be constant companions to her. We lost a dear member of our family when she passed away in 2004.

From my own experience, I think the relationships and bonds that result from the holiday events are of tremendous value: it's great to be there for Christmas, Easter and Thanksgiving.

But if the match of volunteer and elder really takes hold and an ongoing, meaningful relationship comes to be, **well that's an incredibly powerful gift.**

Every year our programs are supported with in-kind gifts of supplies, foods, event space, and staff. While we can not list everyone here we do want to acknowledge some of these special organizations.
